MONTHLY REPORT-JULY 2023

Key Highlights



A total of 645,832 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 104.99 million were exported in July 2023 at an average price of US\$ 2.71/kilo US cent 3 higher compared to June 2023 (US \$ 2.68/kilo), and US cents 30 higher than US\$ 2.41/kilo in July 2022. This was an increase of 12.16% and 25.85% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,000 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,000 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 10,250 per kilo and Drugar UGX 9,250 per kilo.



Coffee exports for 12 months (August 2022-July 2023) totaled 5.83 million bags worth US\$ 867.50 million compared to 6.13 million bags worth US\$ 862.28 million the previous year (August 2021-July 2022). This represents a decrease of 5% in quantity and 0.6% increase in value.



72% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 53 companies which performed during the month compared to 71% in June 2023.

Mt. Elgon AA fetched the highest price at US \$ 6.15 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in July 2023 amounted to 645,832 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 104.99 million as shown in Fig 1. This comprised 586,871 bags of Robusta valued at US \$ 92.59 million and 58,961 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 12.40 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 12.16% and 25.85% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Coffee Year (July 2022), Robusta increased by 11.40% and 29.79% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports increased by 20.33% and 2.59% in quantity and value respectively.

The monthly coffee exports performance was higher than the previous year which was seen in Robusta exports and was partly on account of a good crop harvest in South-Western region and the prevailing good prices on the global scene which prompted exporters to release their stocks.

Coffee exports for 12 months (August 2022-July 2023) totaled 5.83 million bags worth US\$ 867.50 million compared to 6.13 million bags worth US\$ 862.28 million the previous year (August 2021-July 2022). This represents a decrease of 5% in quantity and 0.6% increase in value. The decrease was pegged on a drought and increasing incidence of pests and diseases in Robusta growing areas.

Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee exports August 2022- July 2023

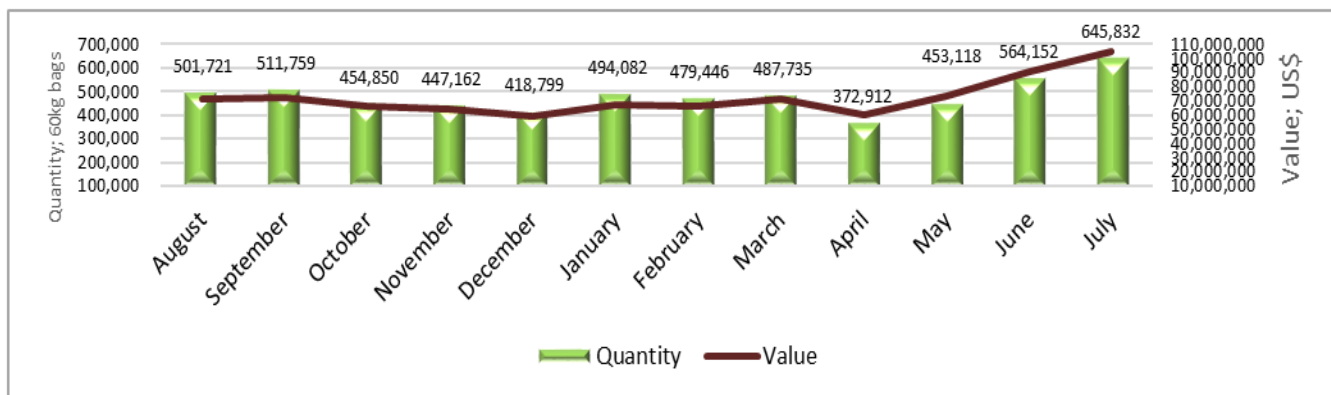

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of July 2023. The average export price was US\$ 2.71 per kilo, US cent higher lower than in June 2023 (US \$ 2.68/kilo). It was 30 US cents higher than in July 2022 (US \$ 2.41/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 91% of total exports higher than 87% in June 2023. The average Robusta price was US\$ 2.63 per kilo, 12 cents higher than US\$ 2.51 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US \$ 2.99 per kilo, a premium of 19 cents above Screen 18. This was followed by Organic Robusta sold at US\$ 2.93 per kilo. Worth noting are lower fair trade prices offered compared to the Conventional grades

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.63% lower than 1.15% in June 2023.

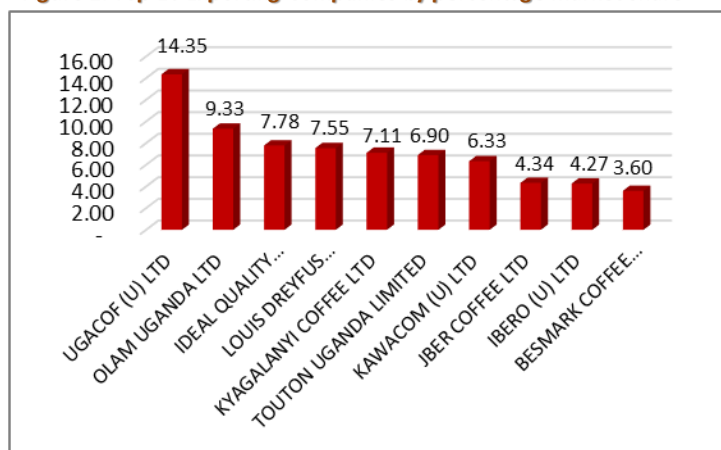
Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 3.50 per kilo, US cents 25 lower than US\$ 3.75 per kilo realized in June 2023. The highest price was for Mt. Elgon AA sold at US\$ 6.15 per kilo. It was followed by Mt. Elgon A+ sold at US\$ 5.52 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 3.49 per kilo, a discount of US cents 84 from Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 58% of total Arabica exports compared to 60% the previous month.. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 1.24% lower than 7% in June 2023.

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of July 2023. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 14.35% compared to 15.77% in July 2023. It was followed by Olam Uganda Ltd 9.33% (9.54%); Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 7.78% (10.30%) Louis Dreyfus Company (U) Ltd 7.55% (8.22%); Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 7.11% (6.12%), Touton Uganda Limited 6.90% (5.96%); Kawacom (U)Ltd 6.33% (5.17%); JBER Coffee Ltd 4.34% (5.03%); Ibero (U)Ltd 4.27% (3.88%); and Besmark Coffee Company Limited 3.60% (2.59%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in June 2023.

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 72% higher than 71% the previous month reflecting increasing competition. Changes in exporter positions compared to last month show competition at this level. Out of the 53 exporters that performed, 32 exported Robusta Coffee only while 6 exported Arabica coffee only. **Annex 2** shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in July 2023.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of July 2023 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 4**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 37.80% compared to 37.68% last month. It was followed by Sudan 18.37% (15.77%), Germany 10.96% (12.13%), India 7.51% (7.85%) and Morocco 4.21% (1.67%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in June 2023.*

The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 90.64% compared to 90.13% last month. Coffee exports to Africa amounted to 157,752 bags, a market share of 24% compared to 1,03,285 bags (18%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Morocco, Algeria, South Africa, Egypt, and Kenya. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 61% imports share, lower than 64% in June 2023.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Ugandan coffee foreign buyers in July 2023. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 62% of total exports, lower than 64% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 14.51% compared to 13.95% in June 2023. It was followed by Olam International 9.69% (10.28%); Louis Dreyfus 7.43% (8.16%); Touton SA 7.05% (5.96%); Ecom Agro Industrialist 6.80% (5.40%) Bernhard Rothfos 4.22% (3.88%); Hafco Trading 3.36%; Volcafe 3.09% (3.12%) Altasheel Import and Export Enterprises 3.03%, (4.40%) Icona Cafe 2.50% (2.26%) *Note: The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month – June 2023.*

There were changes in the relative positions of the first 10 major buyers reflecting continued demand for Uganda coffee abroad.

Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share

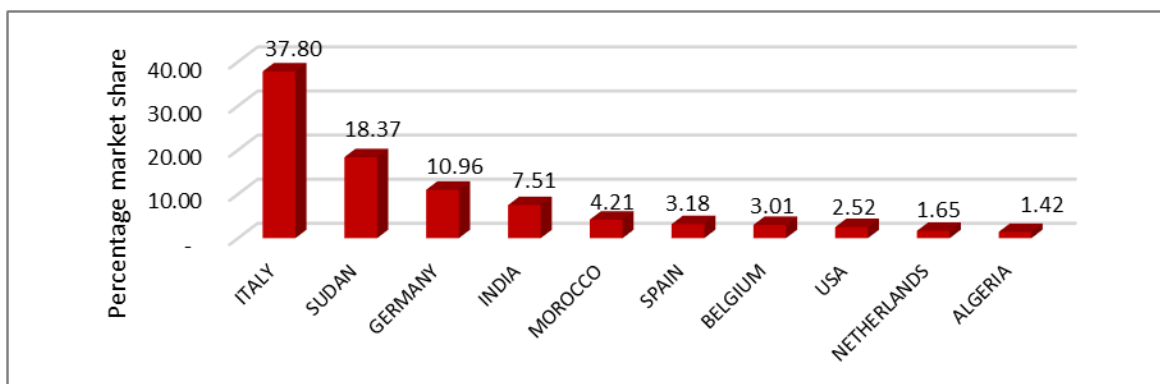


Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent

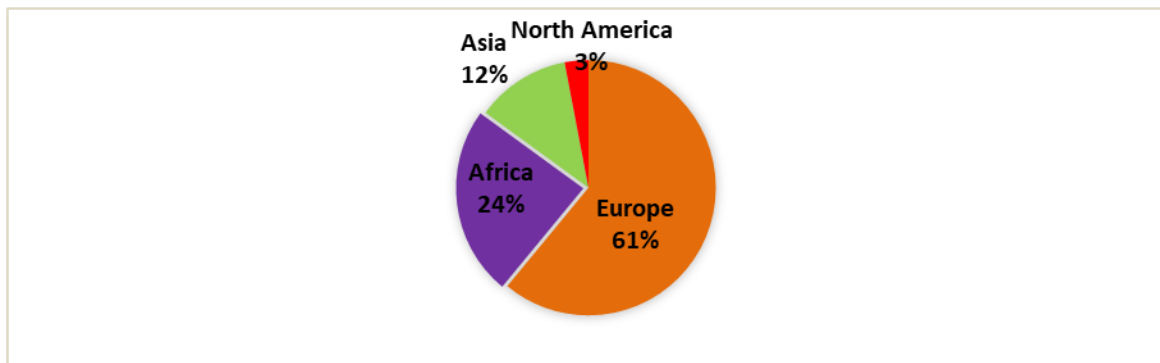
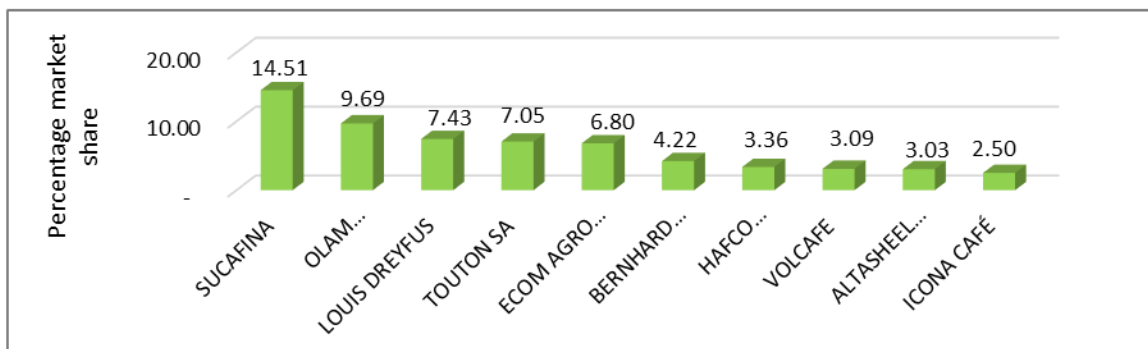


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2023/24 is forecast to increase by 4.3 million bags from the previous year to 174.3 million due primarily to higher output from Brazil and Vietnam. Global consumption is forecast at 170.2 million, with the largest gains in the European Union, the United States of America and Brazil. World coffee bean exports are forecast to increase by 5.8 million bags to reach 122.2 million bags higher than 116.4 million, fueled by strong shipments from Brazil. Ending stocks are expected to be 31.8 million. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2023).

7. Local Situation

During the month of July 2023, farm gate prices ranged from Sh.3,800-4,200/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs. 7,800-8,200/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 10,000- 10,500/= for Arabica parchment; and Sh. 9,000-9,500/= per kilo for Drugar from Kasese. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,000 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,000 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 10,250 per kilo and Drugar UGX 9,250/= per kilo.

8. Coffee Development and Promotional Activities

In the month of July 2023, most parts of the country experienced dry conditions with moderate levels of rain were received Elgon region. The weather was characterized by high temperatures. The field team established 74 coffee demo sites: 6 for rehabilitation (2 in Western(2M), 4 in Western (4M)) and 68 for GAPs (28 in Western(22 Male 6 Female,1 Youth), 35 in Eastern(31 Male ,4 Female), 5 in Southwest). A total of 19 nurseries (12 in Western, 2 in Eastern, 5 in Rwenzori), 6 mother gardens (4 in Rwenzori, 2 CWDr in Eastern) and 1 seed garden(1F) in Elgon were visited to ensure multiplication of good quality planting materials. A total of 70,316 old and unproductive coffee trees were stumped: 63,550 coffee trees were stumped in Western by 45 farmers (42 Male,3 Female), 1100 in Southwestern by 1 farmer(1Male) 860 in Rwenzori and 4806 trees in Eastern. Distribution of 10 boxes of copper nordox, 4 boxes of Tebuconazole and 7 boxes of liquid fertilizer in Eastern (Iganga) to 35 demo farmers for control and management of red blister disease was also undertaken to demonstrate the control of the pests and disease. The roll-out of the geospatial system and registration App for field testing on registration of coffee value chain actors commenced in all coffee regions. So far 589 farmers were registered as follows: 221 in Western(196M,25F,17Y), 126 in Rwenzori (100 Male,26 Female), 125 in Central (102 Male,23 Female), 92 in Eastern(80 Male,12 Female,4 Youth), 25 in Northern);254 farms were registered (61 in Western (57 Male,4 Female,6 Youth), 81 in Northern, 66 in Rwenzori, 46 in Eastern); 22 cooperatives (12 in Eastern, 10 in Greater Masaka); 5 nursery operators in Eastern, 9 nurseries(5 Male,4 Female); 13 factories and 11 traders all male in Western. The coffee extension outreach recorded 129 farmer trainings benefiting 2,224 farmers (1759M,465F,218Y). The trainings were complimented with 11 radio talk shows. On the other hand, other technical extension services conducted included the registration of 202 value chain actors (11 stores, 6 hullers, 27 buyers and 127 factories). The pests and disease surveillance missions undertaken revealed that the Black coffee twig borer (BCTB) and Coffee Berry Borer (CBB) were the major pests observed in most Robusta growing regions, while Coffee leaf rust and the Red Blister Disease (RBD) were common in both Arabica and Robusta growing areas.

9. Outlook for August 2023

Coffee exports are projected to be 600,000 bags. The main harvesting season in Greater Masaka and South-Western regions which will is at the tail end.
