MONTHLY REPORT-AUGUST 2023

Key Highlights



A total of 743,517 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 121.64 million were exported in August 2023 at an average price of US\$ 2.73/kilo US cent 2 higher compared to July 2023 (US \$ 2.71/kilo), and US cents 36 higher than US\$ 2.41/kilo in August 2022. This was an increase of 48.19% and 70.73% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,000 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,000 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 10,250 per kilo and Drugar UGX 9,250 per kilo.



Coffee exports for 12 months (September 2022-August 2023) totaled 6.08 million bags worth US\$ 918.76 million compared to 5.94 million bags worth US\$ 872.00 million the previous year (September 2021-August 2023). This represents an increase of 5% and 2% increase in quantity and value respectively.



76% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 51 companies which performed during the month compared to 72% in June 2023.

Bugisu A+ fetched the highest price at US \$ 5.37 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in August 2023, the highest ever, amounted to 743,517 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 121.64 million as shown in Fig 1. This comprised 689,261 bags of Robusta valued at US \$ 111.41 million and 54,256 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 10.22 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 48.19% and 70.73% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Coffee Year (August 2022), Robusta increased by 50.95% and 84.76% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports increased by 20.29% in quantity but a 6.61% reduction in value.

The monthly coffee exports performance was higher than the previous year which was seen in Robusta exports and was partly on account of a good crop harvest in South-Western region and the prevailing good prices on the global scene which prompted exporters to release their stocks.

Coffee exports for 12 months (September 2022-August 2023) totaled 6.08 million bags worth US\$ 918.76 million compared to 5.94 million bags worth US\$ 872.00 million the previous year (September 2021-August 2023). This represents an increase of 5% and 2% increase in quantity and value respectively.

Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee exports September 2022- August 2023

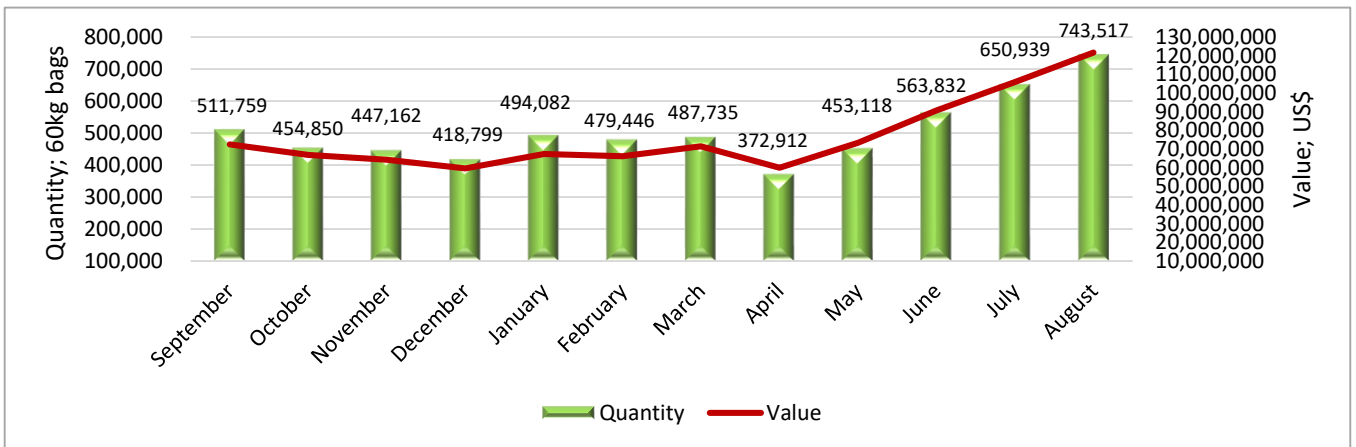

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of August 2023. The average export price was US\$ 2.73 per kilo, 2 US cents higher than in July 2023 (US \$ 2.71/kilo). It was 36 US cents higher than in August 2022 (US \$ 2.37/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 93% of total exports higher than 91% in July 2023. The average Robusta price was US\$ 2.69 per kilo, 6 cents higher than US\$ 2.63 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Screen 14 sold at US \$ 2.96 per kilo, and it was followed by Organic Robusta sold at US\$ 2.95 per kilo. Washed Robusta was sold at US\$ 2.84 per dollars, 3 cents higher than conventional Screen 18.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.54% compared to 0.63% in July 2023.

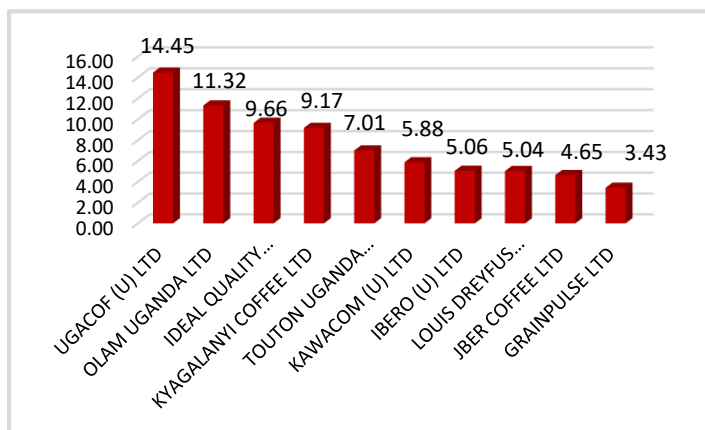
Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 3.14 per kilo compared to 3.50 per kilo last month, US cents 25 lower than US\$ 3.75 per kilo realized in July 2023. The highest price was Bugisu A+ sold at US\$ 5.37 per kilo. It was followed by Bugisu CPB sold at US\$ 4.74 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 3.35 per kilo, 14 cents lower than 3.49 per kilo last month. This price was US cents 46 from Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 48% of total Arabica exports compared to 58% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 6.64% compared to only 1.24% in July 2023.

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of August 2023. Still, Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 14.45% compared to 14.35% in July 2023. It was followed by Olam Uganda Ltd 11.32% (9.33%); Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 9.66% (7.78%); Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 9.17% (7.11%), Touton Uganda Limited 7.01% (6.90%); Kawacom (U)Ltd 5.88% (6.33%); Ibero (U)Ltd 5.06% (4.27%); Louis Dreyfus Company (U) Ltd 5.04% (7.55%); JBER Coffee Ltd 4.65% (4.34%); and Grain Pulse Limited 3.43% (2.65%)

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 76% higher than 72% the previous month reflecting increasing competition. Changes in exporter positions compared to last month show competition at this level. Out of the 51 exporters who performed, 27 exported Robusta Coffee only while 5 exported Arabica coffee only. **Annex 2** shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in August 2023.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of August 2023 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 4**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 30.27% compared to 37.68% last month. It was followed by Sudan 22.11% (18.37%), Germany 11.00% (10.96%), India 9.59% (7.51%) and Algeria 4.86% (1.42%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in July 2023.*

The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 90.35% compared to 90.64% last month. Coffee exports to Africa amounted to 225,141 bags, a market share of 30% compared to 157,752 bags (24%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Morocco, Algeria, South Africa, Egypt, and Kenya. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 53% imports share, lower than 61% in July 2023.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Ugandan coffee foreign buyers in August 2023. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 66% of total exports, higher than 62% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 15.00% compared to 14.51% in July 2023. It was followed by Olam International 11.63% (9.69%); Touton SA 7.33% (7.05%); Hafco Trading 5.23% (3.36%); Ecom Agro Industrialist 5.22% (6.80%) Bernhard Rothfos 5.19% (4.22%); Volcafe 4.60%; (3.09%) Louis Dreyfus 4.59% (7.43%) Aldwami Company 3.91%, (2.01%) Altasheel Import & Export Enterprises 3.58% (3.03%) *Note: The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month – July 2023.*

There were changes in the relative positions of the first 10 major buyers reflecting continued demand for Uganda coffee abroad.

Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share

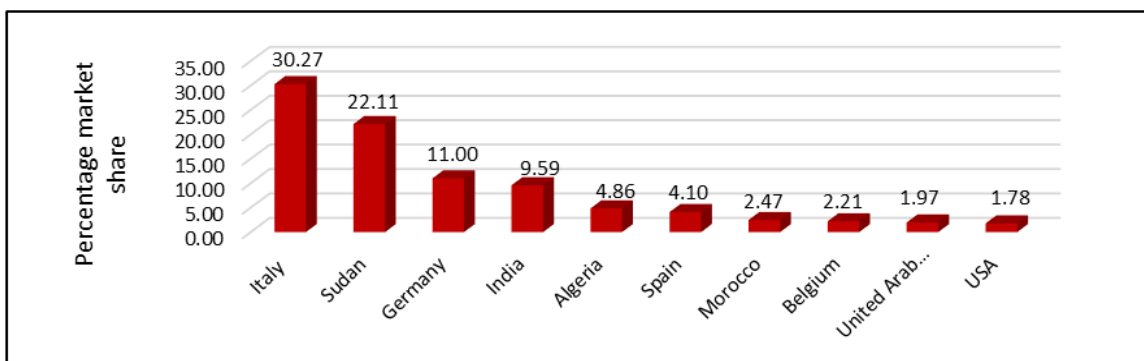


Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent

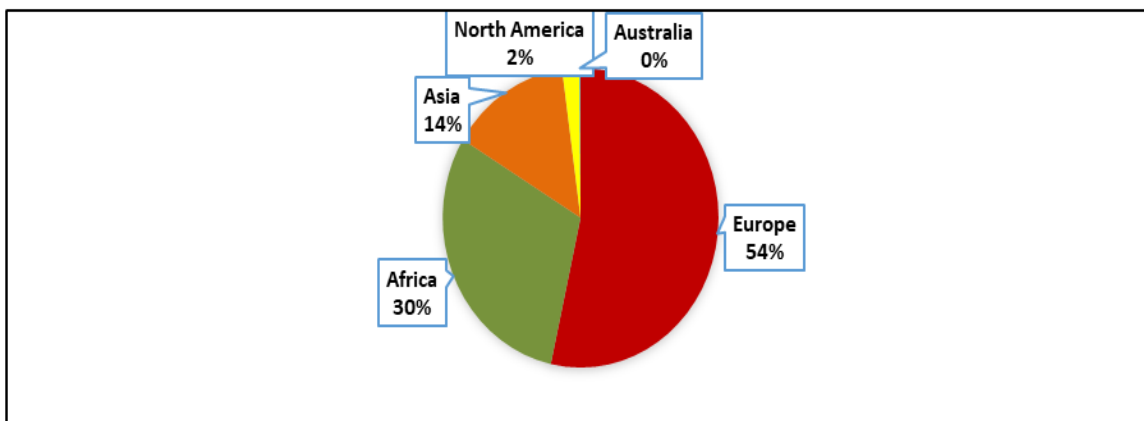
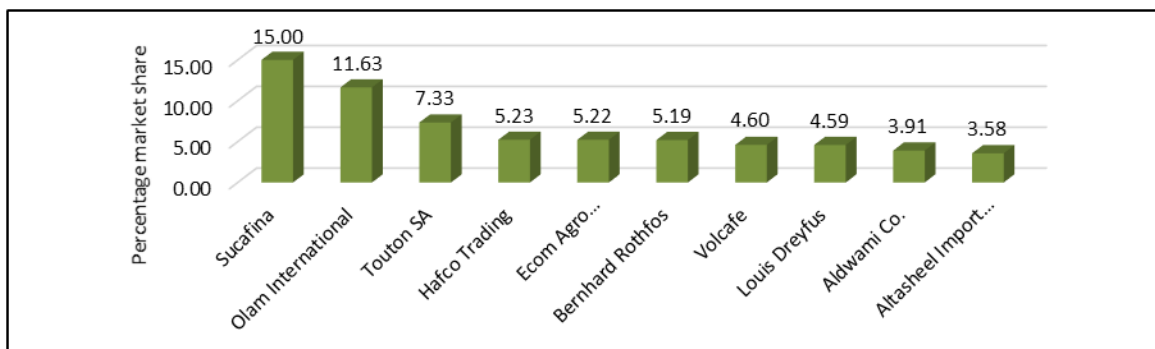


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2023/24 is forecast to increase by 4.3 million bags from the previous year to 174.3 million due primarily to higher output from Brazil and Vietnam. Global consumption is forecast at 170.2 million, with the largest gains in the European Union, the United States of America and Brazil. World coffee bean exports are forecast to increase by 5.8 million bags to reach 122.2 million bags higher than 116.4 million, fueled by strong shipments from Brazil. Ending stocks are expected to be 31.8 million. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2023).

7. Local Situation

During the month of August 2023, farm gate prices ranged from Sh.3,800-4,500/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs. 7,700-8,300/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 9,000- 10,000/= for Arabica parchment; and Sh. 8,000-8,500/= per kilo for Drugar from Kasese. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,150 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,000 per kilo same as the previous month, Arabica parchment UGX 9,500 per kilo lower than 10,250 per kilo last month and Drugar UGX 8,250/= per kilo lower than 9,250/= per kilo last month.

8. Coffee Development and Promotional Activities

During the month of August 2023, the major activity undertaken was the pilot for digital registration of coffee farmers/farms and other coffee value chain actors for purposes of coffee traceability and obtaining planning data as highlighted in the National Coffee Act, 2021. Ten (10) nurseries were registered in Western (5 male, 5 female,1 youth); 88 farm inspections/visits (36 in Greater Masaka to 156(118 male, 38 Female ,16 youth), 15 in South-western to 15(11 male,4 female), 33 in Central to 104(88 male,16 female), 4 in Northern) and 30 mother gardens mapped (22M,8F,5Y) in Greater Masaka. Farmer registration and traceability has become more urgent with the recent mandatory requirements of EU regulations. In September, 2023 UCDA has planned to conduct a Master Trainers Course on digital farmer registration and coffee traceability system for 100 DLG Extension staff of Western and Elgon region, and 80 Extension staff of UCDA. 134 farmer trainings were conducted to 3,059 farmers (2,322 male,737 female,301 youth); 12 in Western region to 354 farmers (308 male, 46 female,33 Youth), 2 in Elgon to 62 farmers (45 male,17 Female, 30 Youth), 11 in Rwenzori to 636 farmers (447 male,189 female), 13 in Northern to 302 farmers (240 male,62 female,71 youth), 9 in Greater Masaka to 217 farmers (149 male,68 female,16 youth), 21 in Central to 449 farmers (327 male,122 female, 35 youth), 26 in Eastern to 829 farmers (620 male,209 female,106 youth), 40 in South-western to 210 farmers (186 male, 24 female, 10 youth) focusing on basically Good Agronomic Practices (GAPs), stumping, pest and disease management, soil fertility management, soil and water conservation. The trainings were complimented with 421 farm visits reaching 1,299 farmers (1040 male,259 female,136 youth). The major pests and disease incidences recorded included, the Black coffee twig borer (BCTB) and the Coffee Berry Borers (CBB) recorded in Eastern, South-western, Central, Greater Masaka and Western regions. Red blister disease was prevalent in Eastern, Western, South-western and Central. Coffee leaf rust was reported in Elgon, Northern, South-western. In some regions, Coffee berry disease and coffee leaf rust have been reported in Elgon, Northern, Western high in South-western and coffee wilt disease in South-western, Greater Masaka are devastating coffee plantations. Root mealy bugs, green scales, Armillaria root rot, coffee leaf skeletonizers, stem mealybugs, antestia bugs, termites are still main constraints in Western, Northern, Eastern, Elgon and Rwenzori regions.

9. Outlook for September 2023

Coffee exports are projected to be 600,000 bags. The main harvesting season in Greater Masaka and South-Western regions is at the tail end and exporters will drawdown on their stocks to fulfil contractual obligations with buyers. They are also preparing for the main harvest north of the equator which is soon starting especially in Mt. Elgon region.
