MONTHLY REPORT-AUGUST 2024

Key Highlights



A total of 837,915 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 221.63 million were exported in August 2024 at an average price of US\$ 4.41/kilo, US cents 14 higher than US\$ 4.27/Kilo in July 2024, and US\$ 1.68 higher than US\$ 2.73/kilo in August 2023. This was an increase of 13.15% and 82.98% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,250 per kilo; FAQ UGX 12,500 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 12,750 per kilo and Drugar UGX 11,500 per kilo.



Coffee exports for twelve months (September 2023-August 2024) totaled 6.39 million bags worth US\$ 1.35 billion compared to 6.08 million bags worth US\$ 918.41 million in the previous year (September 2022-August 2023). This represents an increase of 5.25% and 46.96% in quantity and value respectively.



75% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 66 companies which performed during the month compared to 69% in June 2024.

Sustainable Arabica fetched the highest price at US \$ 5.58 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in August 2024, amounted to 837,915 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 221.63 million as shown in Fig 1. This comprised of 785,667 bags of Robusta valued at US \$ 208.14 million and 52,248 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 13.49 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 13.15% and 82.98% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Year (August 2023), Robusta increased by 14.33% and 87.38% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports decreased by 2.01% in quantity and increased by 34.33% in value.

The monthly coffee exports volume was higher than the previous year. Robusta exports were higher as exporters continue to release the stocks. Arabica exports were lower than the previous year due to a smaller harvest in Elgon region due to the bi annual off year cycle coupled with poor flowering in the region. The value of coffee exports was higher as global coffee prices continue to rise as dry conditions in Brazil and Vietnam are seen to affect coffee crop yields and, therefore, a likelihood of supply deficit in 2024/25 .

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Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee exports. September 2023- August 2024

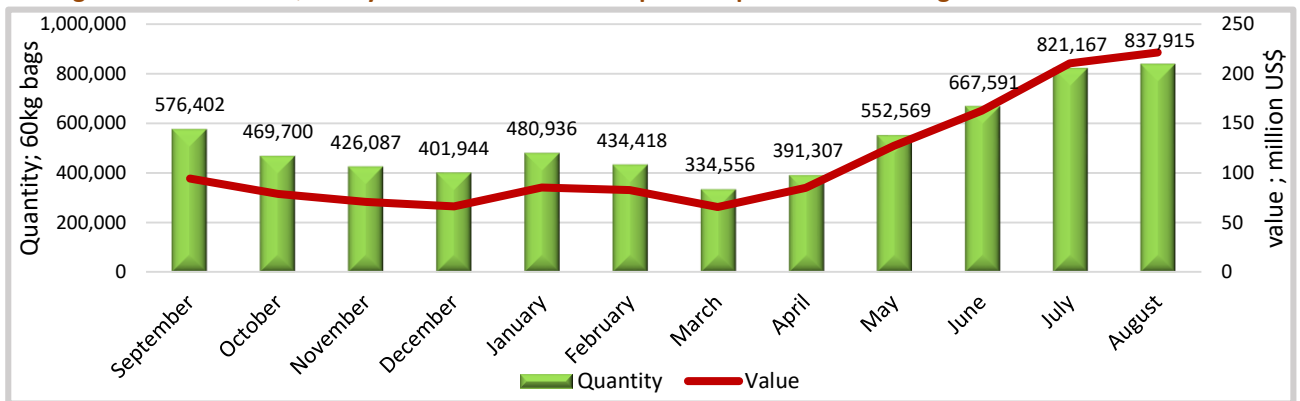

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of August 2024. The average export price was US\$ 4.41 per kilo, US cents 14 higher than in July 2024 (US\$ 4.27). It was US\$ 1.68 higher than in August 2023 (US \$ 2.73/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 94% of total exports, the same as in July 2024. The average Robusta price was US\$ 4.42 per kilo, 15 cents higher than US\$ 4.27 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Organic Robusta sold at US\$ 5.04 per kilo, followed by Screen 18 and Screen 14 sold at US\$ 4.57 per kilo.

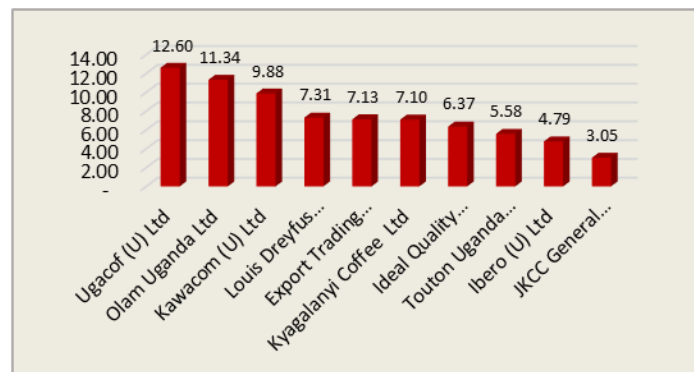
3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of August 2024. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 12.60% compared to 16.26% in July 2024. It was followed by Olam Uganda Ltd 11.34% (10.50%); Kawacom (U) Ltd 9.88% (5.52%), Louis Dreyfus Company (U) Ltd 7.31% (8.41%), Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 7.13% (6.39%), Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 7.10% (5.13%), Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 6.00% (6.37%), Touton Uganda Ltd 5.58% (5.76%), Ibero (U) Ltd 4.79% (5.30%) and JKCC General Supplies Ltd 3.05% (4.59%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in July 2024.

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 75% higher than 74% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 66 exporters who performed, 40 exported Robusta Coffee only while 7 exported Arabica coffee only. **Annex 2** shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in July 2024.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 2.2% compared to 0.86% in July 2024. Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 4.30 per kilo US cents 7 higher than the previous month (US\$ 4.23). The highest price was for sustainable Arabica Sipi Falls sold at US\$ 5.58 per kilo. It was followed by Organic Bugisu sold at US\$ 5.57 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 4.52 per kilo, 13 cents higher than 4.39 per kilo last month, and was US cents 45 lower than Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 54% of total Arabica exports the same as the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 7%, higher than 2% in July 2024.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of August 2024 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 4**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 35.37% compared to 40.68% last month. It was followed by Germany 20.83% (15.75%), India 7.08% (5.26%), Sudan 5.43% (5.41%) and Netherlands 4.94% (4.14%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in July 2024.*

The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 89.17% compared to 88.97% last month. Coffee exports to African countries totaled 101,562 bags, a market share of 12% compared to 112,713 bags (14%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Morocco, Algeria, Egypt, Tunisia, Senega,l Kenya, and South Africa. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 73% imports share, higher than 72% in July 2024.

Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent

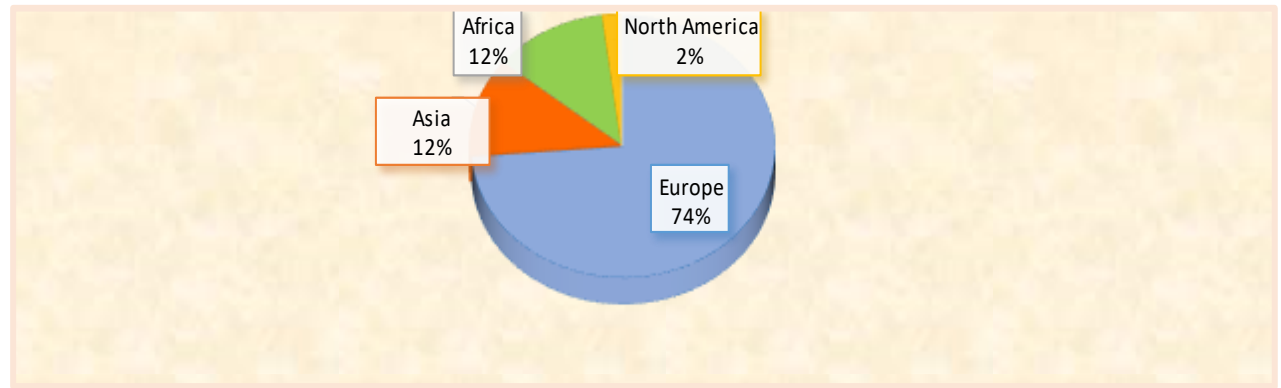
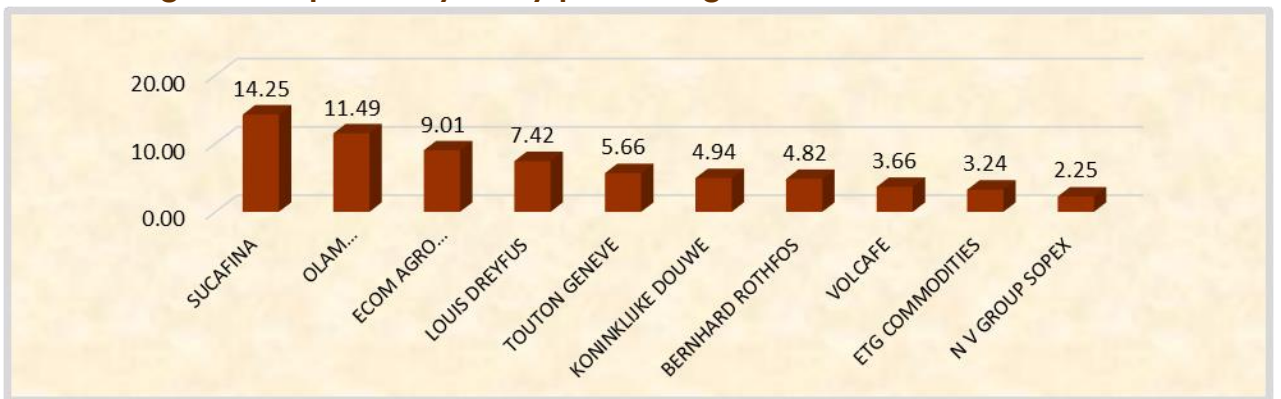


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in August 2024. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 67% higher than 64% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 14.25% compared to 16.64% in July 2024. It was followed by Olam International 11.49% (10.94%); Ecom Agro Industrialist 9.01% (4.84%) Louis Dreyfus 7.42% (8.41%); Touton SA 5.66% (6.49%); Koninklijke Douwe 4.94% (3.81%); Bernahard Rothfos 4.82% (5.30%) Volcafe 3.66% (3.13%); ETG Commodities 3.24% (1.45%) and N.V Group Sopex 2.25% (0.88%) *Note: The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month –July 2024.*

6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2024/25 is forecast to increase by 7.1 million bags from the previous year to 176.2 million due primarily to continued recovery in Brazil and rebounding output in Indonesia. With additional supplies, global exports are expected to increase by 3.6 million bags to 123.1 million primarily on strong shipments from Indonesia and Brazil. Consumption is seen to be 3.1 million bags higher to 170.6 million. Ending stocks are expected to rise by 1.9 million bags to 25.8 million following 3 years of decline. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2024).

8. Coffee Consumption and Promotional Activities.

During the month, Uganda Coffee Development Authority (UCDA) promoted coffee consumption at three events.

The Consecration and Enthronement of the 6th Bishop of Bunyoro-Kitara Diocese held on the 11th of August 2024.

The Innovation exhibition held at the Petete Primary School in Butebo District from the 20th to 22nd August 2024. This event that was organized by the Science, Technology and innovation Secretariat.

The 10th Annual school farm camp at Gayaza high school held on 26th August 2024. The students were trained on value addition and on all other stages of coffee value chain.

Over 2400 cups of different coffee beverages were provided for tasting and different brewing techniques demonstrated. UCDA shared information on good agronomic practices, coffee processing, coffee trade, investment opportunities in the sector, coffee types, grades, and benefits of taking coffee were explained to over 10,000 participants

7. Local Situation

During the month of August 2024, farm gate prices ranged from Shs 6,000-6,500/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs.11,500-12,500/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 12,500- 13,000/= for Arabica Parchment; and Sh. 10,500-11,500/= per kilo for Drugar. Compared to the previous month, Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 6,250/= higher than 5,900/= Robusta FAQ averaged UGX 12,500/= higher than UGX 12,000, Arabica parchment UGX 12,750 per kilo the same as the pervious month Drugar UGX 11,500/= per kilo higher than UGX 11,000 per kilo the previous month.

9. Coffee Development Activities

In August 2024, UCDA successfully built the capacity of 3,130 farmers (2,108 male, 1,022 female, 586 youth, 25 persons with disabilities, and 163 elderly) through 99 specialized trainings across coffee-growing regions. These trainings focused on Good Agricultural Practices (GAP), Sustainable Land Management (SLM), Climate-Smart Agriculture, and Environmental Management. Key topics included preparation for new coffee planting, managing young coffee fields, coffee rehabilitation, soil fertility management, soil and water conservation, as well as pest and disease control. The regional breakdown of the trainings is as follows: **Rwenzori**: 10 trainings for 262 farmers (202 male, 60 female, 28 youth); **Central**: 20 trainings for 871 farmers (367 male, 504 female, 179 youth, 3 PWDs); **Elgon**: 18 trainings for 485 farmers (292 male, 193 female, 96 youth); **Western**: 14 trainings for 520 farmers (419 male, 101 female, 53 youth, 4 PWDs); **Greater Masaka**: 2 trainings for 49 farmers (31 male, 18 female, 16 youth, 2 PWDs, 8 elderly); **Northern**: 3 trainings for 49 farmers (32 male, 17 female, 6 youth, 3 PWDs); **Eastern**: 32 trainings for 894 farmers (765 male, 129 female, 208 youth, 13 PWDs, 155 elderly).

UCDA collected and analyzed 234 soil samples from 201 farmers (158 male, 43 female, 9 youth). The analysis revealed low levels of organic matter, potassium, nitrogen, and phosphorus in many samples. Based on these findings, farmers received customized soil amendment recommendations to improve their soil fertility. Meanwhile, support for Value Chain Stakeholders was provided using the Geospatial M&E system and the Farmer Registration App. UCDA registered: **Farmers**: 528 (424 male, 104 female, 40 youth, 23 elderlies, 4 PWDs); **Farms**: 428; **Buying Stores**: 48 (45 male, 3 female); **Hullers**: 58 (54 male, 4 female); **Buyers**: 11 (9 male, 2 female) across the country.

9. Outlook for SEPTEMBER 2024

Coffee exports are projected to be 700,000 60-kilobags as exporters continue to release stocks.
