## **MONTHLY REPORT-MAY 2023**

# **Key Highlights**



A total of 453,169 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 73.26 million were exported in May 2023 at an average price of US\$ 2.68/kilo, US cents 24 higher than US\$ 2.44 /kilo in April 2023, and US cents 2 higher than US\$ 2.67/kilo in May 2022. This was a decrease of 0.38% in quantity but an increase of 0.53% in value compared to the same month last year.

Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 3,750 per kilo; FAQ UGX 7,750 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 9,250 per kilo and Drugar UGX 8.250 per kilo.





Coffee exports for 12 months (June 2022-May 2023) totaled 5.73 million bags worth US\$ 838.78 million compared to 6.35 million bags worth US\$ 837,04 million the previous year (June 2021-May 2022). This represents a decrease of 10% in quantity but an increase of 0.2% in value.



76% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 56 companies which performed during the month, the same as in April 2023.

Mt. Elgon PB fetched the highest price at US \$ 8.71 per kilo.

#### 1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in May 2023 amounted to 453,169 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 73.26 million as shown in Fig 1. This comprised 328,151 bags of Robusta valued at US \$45.63 million and 125,018 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 27.63 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was a decrease of 0.38% in quantity abut an increase of 0.53% in value compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Coffee Year (May 2022), Robusta decreased by 6.25% and 3.31% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports increased by 19.23% and 7.58% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

The monthly coffee exports performance was lower than the previous year which was seen in Robusta exports and was partly on account of an earlier drought coupled with reduced exports to Sudan reflected in the market share which reduced from 11% in April 2023 to 7% in May 2023. Arabica exports were higher compared to the same month last year due to an on-year of the biennial cycle characteristic of Arabica coffee production. The decrease in Arabica value was pegged on a seemingly high output from Brazil in Coffee Year.

Coffee exports for 12 months (June 2022-May 2023) totaled 5.73 million bags worth US\$ 838.78 million compared to 6.35 million bags worth US\$ 837,04 million the previous year (June 2021-May 2022). This represents a decrease of 10% in quantity but an increase of 0.2% in value.

#### Fig 1: Trend of Total Quantity and Value of Coffee Exported: June 2022- May 2023



## 2. Exports by Type and Grade

**Table 2** shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of May 2023. The average export price was US\$ 2.69 per kilo, 1 U.S cent higher than US\$ 2.68 per kilo realized in April 2023 and 2 US cents higher than in May 2022 (US \$ 2.67/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 64% of total exports lower than 75% in April 2023. The average Robusta price was US\$ 2.32 per kilo, higher than US\$ 2.20 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US \$ 2.77 per kilo, a premium of 21 cents above Screen 18. This was followed by Screen 18 sold at US\$ 2.56 per kilo.

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 0.78% lower than 2.53% in April 2023.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 3.68 per kilo, US cents 16 higher than US\$ 3.52 per kilo realized in April 2023. The highest price was for Mt. Elgon PB sold at US\$ 8.71 per kilo. It was followed by Rwenzori AA sold at US\$ 6.61 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 3.65 per kilo, a discount of US cents 44 from Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 42% of total Arabica exports compared to 37% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 7% slightly lower than 8% in April 2023.



#### 3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of May 2023. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 18.12% compared to 14.89% in April 2023. It was followed by Olam Uganda Ltd. 10.19% (8.55%); Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd. 8.83% (5.90%) Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd. 8.64% (13.13%); Ibero (U) Ltd. 7.92% (5.19%), Kawacom (U) Ltd. 6.78% (9.00%); Louis Dreyfus Company (U)Ltd. 5.19% (3.63%); Touton Uganda Limited 3.70% (8.72%); JKCC General Supplies Ltd. 3.40% (1.00%); and Export Trading Company (U) Ltd. 2.96% (2.90%) \*The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in April 2023.

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 76% the same as the previous month still reflecting increasing concentration. Changes in exporter positions compared to last month show competition at this level. Out of the 46 exporters that performed, 20 exported Robusta Coffee only while 14 exported Arabica coffee only. Annex 2 shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in May 2023.

# 4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of May 2023 are shown in Fig 3 (details in Annex 3). Italy maintained the highest market share with 37.34% compared to 26.66% last month. It was followed by Germany 17.42% (19.27%), India 10.94% (12.60%), Sudan 7.03% (10.59%) and Spain 4.11% (3.80%). \*The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in April 2023. The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 91.81% compared to 89.94 % last month, reflecting increasing concentration. Coffee exports to Africa amounted to 43,777 bags, a market share of 10% compared to 51,418 bags (14%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Morocco, South Africa, Egypt, Algeria and Kenya. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 71% imports share, higher than 62% in April 2023. There were some changes in relative position of the first ten major destinations with Sudan's market share dropping to 7% from 11% the previous month and 18% in March 2023.

# 5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Ugandan coffee foreign buyers in May 2023. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 68% of total exports, higher than 63% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 17.79% compared to 14.88% in April 2023. It was followed by Olam International 10.34% (9.08%); Bernhard Rothfos 8.37% (5.19%); Ecom Agro industrialist 7.08% (8.15%) Louis Dreyfus 5.61% (4.79%); Hamburg Coffee 4.29% (2.23%); Volcafe 3.96%, (6.50%) Touton Geneve 3.96% (9.10%); Eurocaf Sas 3.69% (0.63%) and GRB 3.40% (3.08%)

Note: The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month – April 2023.

There were changes in the relative positions of the first 10 major buyers reflecting continued demand for Uganda coffee abroad.




Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent





Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



#### 6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2022/23 is forecast to rebound 6.6 million bags from the previous year 172.8 million due primarily to Brazil's Arabica crop entering of the biennial production Global consumption is expected to rise by 800,000 bags to million, with the largest gains in European Union, the United States of America and Brazil. World coffee bean exports are forecast 3.0 million bags lower to 116.1 million as losses in Brazil, Vietnam, and India offset Honduras more than gains in Colombia. Ending stocks are expected 1.5 million bags higher to 34.1 million. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report).

#### 7. Local Situation

During the month of May 2023, farm gate prices ranged from Sh.3,500-4,000/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs. 7,500-8,000/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 9,000- 9,500/= for Arabica parchment; and Sh. 8,000-8,500/= per kilo for Drugar from Kasese. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 3,750 per kilo; FAQ UGX 7,750 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 9,250 per kilo and Drugar UGX 8,250/= per kilo.

# 8. Coffee Development and Promotional Activities

During the month of May 2023, near normal rains received in Elgon, Eastern, Central, South Western and Rwenzori regions favored new planting of coffee. However, uneven rainfall distribution below normal in Mid-Northern affected planting. There was high demand for seedlings which was not met due to inadequate availability especially in Northern Uganda. The Black Coffee Twig Borer (BCTB) and the Red Blister Disease continue to be major biological constraints in Robusta growing regions. Other pests recorded include Root mealy bugs, green scales, Armilleria root rot, stem mealybugs and Antestia bugs in Western, Elgon and Rwenzori regions. Under coffee rehabilitation and renovation, 14,628 old and unproductive coffee trees were stumped (12,300 coffee trees in Western and 2,328 coffee trees in Northern Uganda. In order to control BCTB, 43,942 sachets (20g each) of Imidachloprid were distributed as follows; 2,942 sachets in Eastern to 178 farmers; 22,500 sachets in Western to 469 farmers, 5000 sachets in Greater Masaka to 39 farmers and 13,500 sachets in Rwenzori to 140 farmers. To control coffee leaf rust and Coffee berry disease, 2,800 kg of copper Nordox fungicides were distributed as follows; 300 kg in Elgon to 55 framers and 2500 kg in Rwenzori to 715 farmers. The capacity building programme for coffee farmers recorded 151 training in agronomy benefiting 2,767 farmers. These were complimented with 325 farm visits reaching 2,230 farmers and 19 radio talk shows. The trainings emphasized GAPs, post-harvest handling, coffee rehabilitation, coffee value addition, coffee quality management, pests and disease management, soil conservation measures and sensitization on coffee regulations and the National Coffee Act, 2021. Inspection of coffee facilities included; 225 factories (30 in Central, 69 in Greater Masaka, 25 in Eastern, 25 in Western, 32 in Rwenzori, 6 in Elgon, 38 in South-western); 215 stores (20 in Central, 76 in Greater Masaka, 14 in Eastern, 40 in Western, 14 in Rwenzori, 11 in Elgon, 40 in South-western); 2 roasters (1 in Central, 1 in Elgon); 5 grading facilities (1 in Central, 2 in Elgon, 2 in South-western).

#### 9. Outlook for June 2023

Coffee exports are projected to be 500,000 bags. The main harvesting season in Greater Masaka and South-Western regions which will peak in June/July is ongoing.
