MONTHLY REPORT-MAY 2024

Key Highlights



A total of 553,529 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 127.30 million were exported in May 2024 at an average price of US\$ 3.83/kilo, US cents 21 higher than US\$ 3.62/Kilo in April 2024, and US \$1.14 higher than US\$ 2.69/kilo in May 2023. This was an increase of 22.16% and 73.81% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 5,400 per kilo; FAQ UGX 10,500 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 11,500 per kilo and Drugar UGX 10,500 per kilo.



Coffee exports for the twelve months (June 2023-May 2024) totaled 6.02 million bags worth US\$ 1.07 billion compared to 5.73 million bags worth US\$ 839.18 million in the previous year (June 2022-May 2023). This represents an increase of 5.17% and 27.85% in quantity and value respectively.



72% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 52 companies which performed during the month compared to 68% in April 2024.

Mt. Elgon A+ fetched the highest price at US \$ 5.27 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in May 2024, amounted to 553,529 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 127.30 million as shown in Fig 1. This was comprised of 473,693 bags of Robusta valued at US \$ 107.92 million and 79,836 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 19.38 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was an increase of 22.16% and 73.81% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Year (May 2023), Robusta increased by 44.23% and 136.28% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports decreased by 35.98% and 29.68% in quantity and value respectively.

The monthly coffee exports volume for Robusta was higher than the previous year as the newly harvested main crop from Masaka and South Western regions was at peak. Arabica exports were however lower than last year due to a smaller harvest in Elgon region.

Coffee exports for the twelve months (June 2023-May 2024) totaled 6.02 million bags worth US\$ 1.07 billion compared to 5.73 million bags worth US\$ 839.18 million in the previous year (June 2022-May 2023). This represents an increase of 5.17% and 27.85% in quantity and value respectively.

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of May 2024. The average export price was US\$ 3.83 per kilo, US cents 21 higher than in April 2024 (US\$ 3.62) and US \$1.14 higher than US\$ 2.69/kilo in May 2023 (US\$ 2.69). Robusta exports accounted for 86% of total exports, higher than 74% in April 2024. The average Robusta price was US\$ 3.80 per kilo, 27 cents higher than US\$ 3.53 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Organic Robusta sold at US\$ 4.43 per kilo, followed by Screen 17 at US\$ 4.00 per kilo. The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 1.80% compared to 1.09% in April 2024.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 4.05 per kilo US cents 20 higher than the previous month (US\$ 3.85). The highest price was Mt. Elgon A+ sold at US\$ 5.27 per kilo. It was followed by Organic Bugisu sold at US\$ 4.69 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 4.21 per kilo, 30 cents higher than 3.91 per kilo last month, and was US cents 14 lower than Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 57% of total Arabica exports higher than 53% the previous month. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 4.24% compared to 7.67% in April 2024.

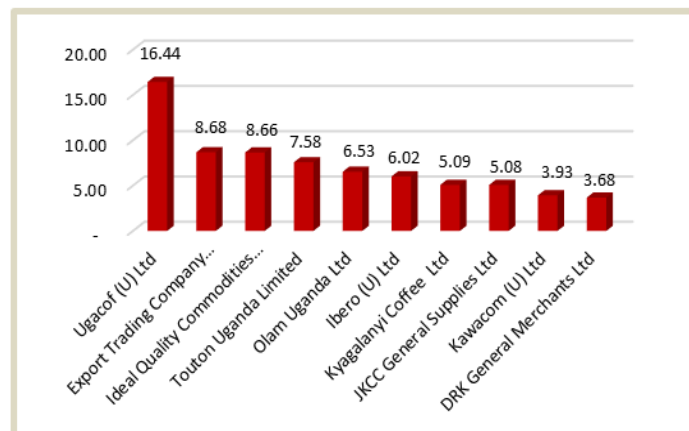

3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of May 2024. Ugacof (U)Ltd had the highest market share of 16.44% compared to 7.86% in April 2024. It was followed by Export Trading Company (U) Ltd 8.68%(6.07%); Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 8.66% (7.26%), Touton Uganda Limited 7.58% (4.79%), Olam Uganda Ltd 6.53%(9.67%), Ibero (U) Ltd 6.02% (6.09%), Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 5.09% (7.77%), JKCC General Supplies Ltd 5.08% (5.47%), Kawacom (U) Ltd 3.93% (6.95%), and DRK General supplies Ltd 3.68% (3.95%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in April 2024.

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 72% higher than 68% the previous month reflecting competition at exporter level. Out of the 52 exporters who performed, 18 exported Robusta Coffee only while 11 exported Arabica coffee only. **Annex 2** shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in May 2024.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda’s coffee exports during the month of May 2024 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 4**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 44.66% compared to 43.87% last month. It was followed by India 9.68% (8.08%), Germany 9.68% (6.89%), Morocco 5.47% (3.71%) and U.S.A 4.88% (7.00%). **The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in April 2024.*

The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 90.58% compared to 86.93% last month. Coffee exports to Africa amounted to 49,909 bags, a market share of 9% compared to 24,583 bags (6%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Morocco, Sudan, Egypt, Kenya, South Africa, Tunisia, Libya and Algeria. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda’s coffees with a 71% imports share, higher than 69% in April 2024.

Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share

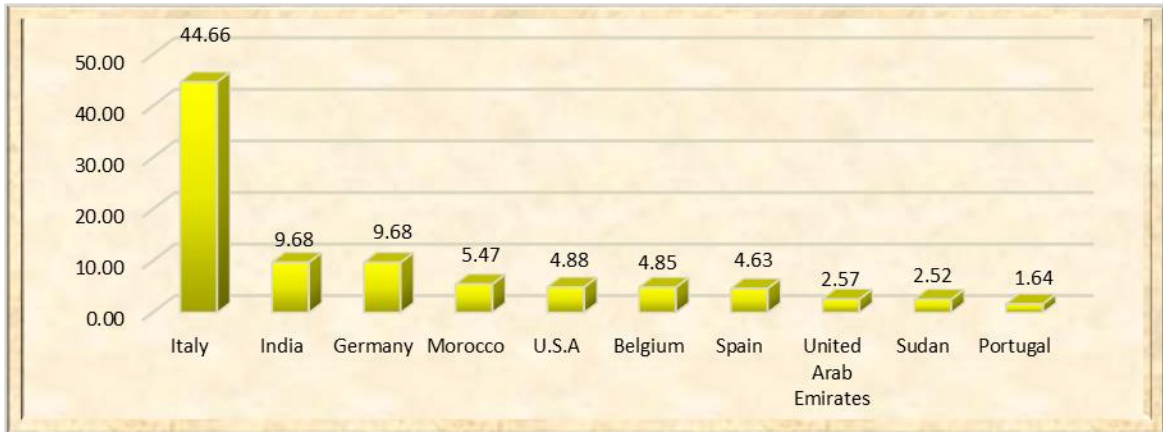


Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent

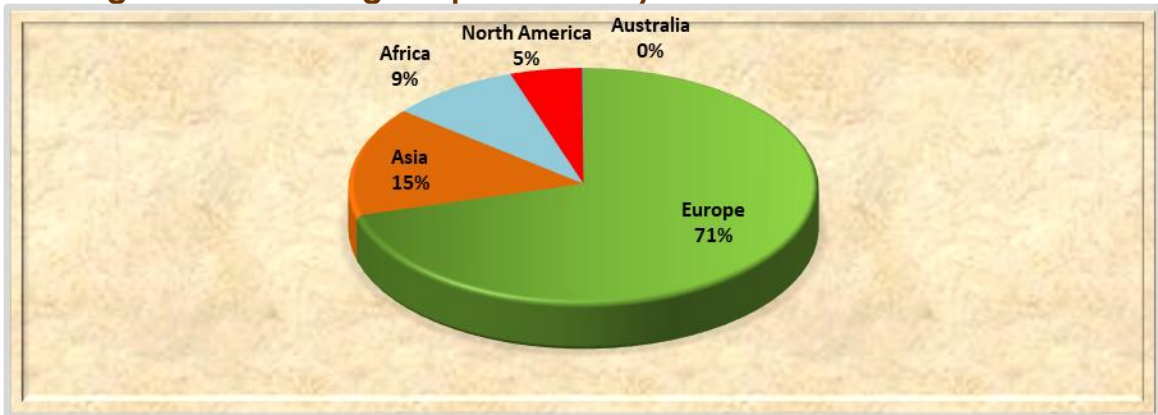
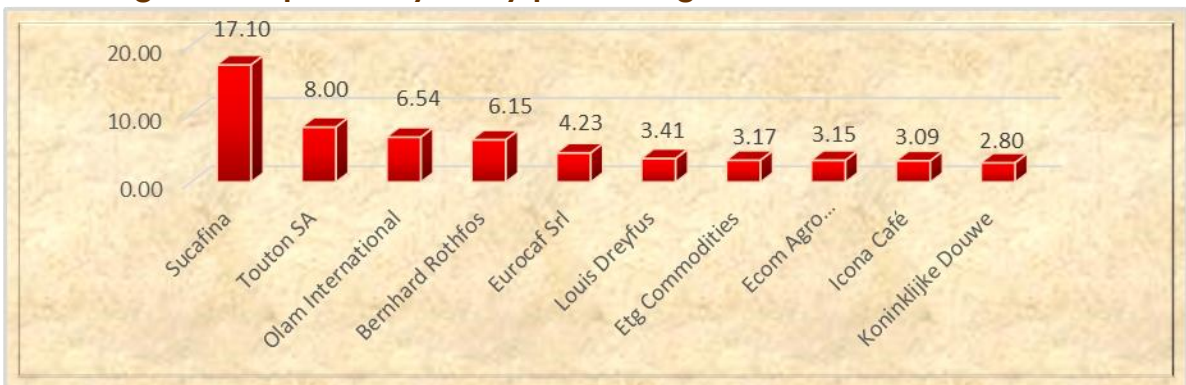


Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Uganda coffee foreign buyers in May 2024. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 58% lower than 59% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 17.10% compared to 8.4% in April 2024. It was followed by Touton SA 8.00 (5.38%); Olam International 6.54%; (9.76%) Bernhard Rothfos 6.15% (6.17%); Eurocaf SRL 6.15% (5.68%); Louis Dreyfus 3.41% (5.65%); ETG Commodities 3.17% (3.40%) Ecom Agro industrialist 3.15% (6.32%); Icona Café 3.09% (1.95%) and Koninklijke Douwe 2.80% (0.82%) Note: *The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month –April 2024.* Changes in the relative positions of the first 10 major buyers reflects continued demand for Uganda coffee abroad.

6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2023/24 is forecast to reach 171.4 million bags, 6.9 million bags higher than the previous Year of 164.5 million bags, due to expected higher production in Brazil, Colombia and Ethiopia. Global exports are expected to increase by 8.4 million bags to 119.92 million bags, mainly due to strong shipments from Brazil. Global consumption is forecast at 169.5 million bags, with the largest increase in the European Union, the United States of America and Brazil. Ending inventories are expected to continue to tighten to a 12-year low of 26.5 million bags. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-December 2023).

7. Local Situation

During the month of May 2024, farm gate prices ranged from Shs 5,000-5,800/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs.10,000-11,000/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 11,000- 12,000/= for Arabica parchment; and Sh. 10,000-11,000/= per kilo for Drugar. Compared to the previous month, Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 5,400 per kilo, lower than UGX 5,750 per kilo the previous month, FAQ UGX 11,500 per kilo lower than UGX 12,250, Arabica parchment UGX 11,500 per kilo lower than UGX 12,750 per kilo and Drugar UGX 10,500/= per kilo lower than UGX 11,750 per kilo higher than the previous month.

8. Coffee consumption and promotional activities.

During the month, Uganda Coffee Development Authority (UCDA) promoted domestic coffee consumption at the following events: the European Union day celebrations held on 9th May 2024 at the EU Ambassador's residence in Kololo, the Women's Days Celebrations held in Sembabule on 18th May 2024, the Pearl of Africa Tourism expo (POATE) organized by the Uganda Tourism board that took place from the 23rd to 25th May at Speke Resort Muyonyo, the Farm Field day celebrations held at Awiodyek Farmers' Cooperative in Lira District on the 28th May 2024. Different brewing techniques were demonstrated to the public and over 10,000 cups of different coffee beverages were provided for tasting. Through interactive discussions, the UCDA team also shared information about the different opportunities along the coffee value chain, information on coffee trade, coffee types, grades, and benefits of taking coffee.

UCDA showcased Uganda's Specialty Arabica and Fine Robusta coffees at the World of Coffee Expo that was held at the BEXCO convention Center in Busan South Korea, from the 1st to the 4th of May 2024.

The expo hosted over 400 exhibitors including producers, equipment manufacturers, associations, and institutes from the coffee industry worldwide with over 10,000 coffee buyers/traders and industry experts in attendance.

The Uganda booth featured one exporter- The Discovery Trading Company Limited and the booth was used to showcase Uganda Specialty and Fine Robusta to a number of potential buyers. At the same event, the Uganda National Barista Champion participated in the World Barista Championship showcasing the uniqueness of Uganda coffee through various beverage preparations. This was used as a platform to further market Uganda coffee.

9. Coffee Development Activities

During May 2024, UCDA aimed at enhancing coffee production and productivity. A total of 161 demonstrations were established on Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs) and Rehabilitation & Renovation (R&R) distributed across all the coffee growing regions. Additionally, 227 Coffee Wilt Disease Resistant (CWDR) nurseries and 2 seed gardens were verified, contributing to the improvement of coffee cultivation.

Soil fertility testing and technical management services were provided to 637 medium and large-scale coffee farmers, identifying areas for improvement such as low pH and nutrient levels. Notably, 116,557 unproductive coffee trees were stumped for 392 coffee farmers, focusing on regions with greater need such as central region. Capacity building sessions reached 4,250 coffee farmers, covering a range of topics including coffee rehabilitation and pest control. Coffee specific advisory services were extended to 1,417 farmers through farm visits and media outreach, emphasizing good agronomic practices and post-harvest handling.

Using Geospatial System and Farmer registration App, coffee value chain actors registration efforts continued in all regions as follows: Country-wide, a total of 442 coffee farmers and 90 coffee farms were registered; 225 CWD-R nurseries; 16 Arabica nurseries; 01 mother garden were registered. This has resulted into the inclusion of numerous farmers, nurseries, and processing units in the coffee value chain. The sector, however, continues to face some challenges including pest infestations, and resistance to registration, highlighting the need for continued collaboration and awareness creation.

9. Outlook for June 2024

Coffee exports are projected to be 550,000 60-kilobags. Harvesting of the main crop south of the equator (Masaka and South Western regions) is at the peak. Harvest of the fly crop North of the equator is also on going.
